

Code of Conduct Agreement

****Before coming to camp, all parents and campers must read and agree to these terms.***

- 1.) Campers/staff age 18 or older must pass a background check prior to arriving at camp.
- 2.) Campers are not permitted to leave the campground without permission from director.
- 3.) All campers are expected to follow the camp schedule.
- 4.) Under no circumstances are boys allowed in girls' cabins or girls in boys' cabins.
- 5.) No pranks will be tolerated in order to promote camp unity.
- 6.) No mixed swimming per Western KY Youth Camp Rules and Regulations. No one is allowed in the pool without a lifeguard present.
- 7.) Golf carts provided for use by Western KY Youth Camp may not be driven by campers.
- 8.) I will abide by the dress code: shorts no shorter than 3 inches above the knee; All shirts must have sleeves on them (no spaghetti straps). Shirts should be long enough that if you raise your hands you cannot see your midriff. If a camper fails to abide by these rules, they will be asked to change.
- 9.) The following behaviors are examples of inappropriate conduct and will not tolerated at camp: bullying, cursing, suggestive language, dirty jokes, racial slurs, inappropriate touching, violent behavior, viewing pornography, etc.
- 10.) Tobacco, alcohol, profanity, knives, fireworks or weapons of any kind are prohibited.
- 11.) Vandalism and stealing will not be tolerated. Any damage to camp equipment or furnishings will be charged to the individuals involved in such behavior.
- 12.) No electronic devices are allowed at camp, with the only exception being a cell phone. However, cell phones *must* remain in the cabin, and can only be used during designated times. If you are caught using your cell phone at a non-designated time or in a non-designated area – your cell phone privileges will be revoked at the discretion of the counselor and/or director. The cell phone will be taken up and returned to you at the end of the week.
- 13.) All campers are expected to conduct themselves in a Christ-like manner at all times while demonstrating proper respect toward adult leaders and fellow campers. Campers are expected to do what the staff asks of them. Especially harmful or persistent disciplinary problems will be handled and addressed by the director.

Any camper who fails to abide by these rules is subject to dismissal from the camp by the director. In such case, a parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up said camper from the campground.
